### Life Insurance

As a member you have FREE life insurance policy that is paid for by both your State and local lodge.

**\$1,000 Life** benefit is paid when a member dies from any cause.

**\$7,500 Accidental Death** is paid in addition to the life benefit when a member dies from accidental bodily injury or exposure or loss of life due to adverse weather conditions, or disappearance for 365 days after the date of an accident.

**\$7,500 Line of Duty** benefit is paid in addition to the Life and Accidental Death benefits when an active at work member is killed in the line of duty.

Expanded Accident Benefits are paid when a member is involved in an accident that directly results in the loss of limbs, hearing, sight and/or speech.

**\$3,750 Occupational Assault** benefit is paid in addition to the Life, Accidental Death & Line of Duty benefits when an active at work member's loss of life occurs as a result of an act of physical violence.

**\$7,500 Seat Belt** benefit is paid in addition to other benefits when a member is killed as a result of an automobile accident while properly utilizing a seat belt system.

In addition to the above, our lodge has the following death benefits:

\$1,500 Death

\$500 Spouse Death Benefit

(All benefits reduce by 50% at age 65)

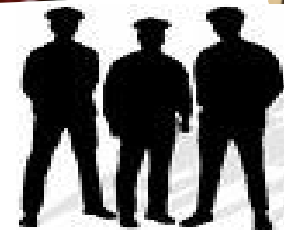

### In-Service Training

Fulton County Lodge #64's training staff works hard planning training for the members to give them a "heads up" in offering POST certified training. We offer a wide variety of subject matter. Also, we are flexible; if you would like to have certain training offered just let our staff know and they will try to make it available. We also have specialized guest instructors.

**Retired members:** House Bill 218 (Federal Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act of 2004) is very important to all retirees because it gives them authority to carry their weapons anywhere in the United States as long as they are in compliance. Effective January 2, 2007, no **Retired** Law Enforcement Lodge Member will be allowed to be qualified or re-qualified under HB 218 until they have completed the mandatory four (4) hour class on **"The Use of Force"**. These classes, along with the Firearms Re-Qualification Classes are offered several times during the year.

### Scholarships

Lodge #64 and the State Lodge award \$1,000 scholarships to its members and spouse/dependants. There is a scholarship application process. The deadlines for submitting applications are: April 1st for the State Lodge and June 1st for the local lodge.



### Legal Defense Plan



You have *limited* legal coverage by the Lodge. This coverage is limited to representation in administrative actions. The amount allocated for the purpose shall consist of the cost of legal representation of initial consultation with FOP Lodge #64 attorney, Atty. Derek H. Jones. However, the FOP Legal Defense Plan Inc. is owned and operated by the National FOP and designed exclusively for the legal defense protection of its law enforcement professionals. The plan coverage includes:

- Administrative
- Civil

- Criminal actions (arising within the scope of law enforcement employment whether on or off duty.)
- Unrestricted choice of your own defense attorney.
